Shapp Calls For Revamp of Delway Ramps

Gov. Shapp, reacting to complaints from center city residents, says he wants ramps planned for the Delaware Expressway redesigned. The governor, however, stopped short of the promise sought by a coalition of residents yesterday to eliminate all ramps planned for the I-95 superhighway between Vine st. and Oregon ave.

At a meeting with Shapp in Harrisburg yesterday, coalition members complained the ramps would spill too much traffic onto the narrow streets in the area.

SHAPP TOLD Transportation Secretary Jacob Kassab to meet with city officials and seek Federal approval to "review the present on-off ramp design . . . to permit us to do everything possible to protect the integrity of those neighborhoods."

The residents, members of the Neighborhood Preservation Coalition, said they were ready to go into court.

Shapp said he wanted to avoid a court fight that could delay completion of the highway until after the 1976 Bicentennial.
